As usual on such scientific meeting, Croatian Society of Hypertension will organise meeting of nurses in hypertension.

Several satellite symposia will be organized by drug industry, in which some specific treatment approaches will be presented and discussed.

Without any doubt this meeting will serve as a bridge not only between basic science, epidemiology and clinical work, but also between different countries from this part of Europe.

First day of the meeting will be organized in Pecs, Hungary city with long-lasting history, impressive cultural heritage and known scientific tradition. The main part of the symposium will take place in Osijek, Croatia, picturesque historic city situated on the right bank of the Drava River, 25 km upstream from its mouth into the river of Danube. This region of Croatia (Slavonia and Baranja) has been inhabited since Neolithic and Roman times (Mursa). Osijek is known by its unique baroque part of the city called Tvrđa (18th century), and by beautiful Secession style buildings in the centre of the town.

You are warmly welcomed and we are looking forward seeing you in Osijek at this fruitful scientific event but also at cultural and social activities!
